#### 7.3 Working Hunter

Judges: Mrs Nicola Fletcher, Invergordon and Mr Robert Scott-Downie, Inverness

- 559 Novice Pony Open to ponies not exceeding 148cm. Rider – any age. Combination of rider/pony not to have won a 1st or 2nd WH prize after 01 January 2019. Fences 60 – 70cm
- 560 Intermediate Pony Open to ponies not exceeding 148cm. Rider any age. Fences 80 90cm
- 561 Open Pony Open to ponies not exceeding 148cm. Rider any age. Fences 95 105cm
- 562 Novice Horse Open to horses exceeding 148cm. Combination of rider/horse not to have won a 1st or 2nd WH prize after 01 January 2019. Fences 80 – 85cm

- 563 Intermediate Horse Open to horses exceeding 148cm. Fences 90 95cm
- 564 Open Horse Open to horses exceeding 148cm. Fences 1m 1.05m

This class is a qualifier for the Botanica/BHS Scotland Working Hunter Series. First 3 qualify for the final to be held at Blair International Horse Trials, 22nd - 25th August 2019

#### NOTE:-

Working Hunter classes will start after completion of the Ridden & In-Hand classes.

In Working Hunter classes - only ONE entry per horse & rider combination is permitted.

In Working Hunter classes, plaiting is encouraged but not compulsory.

#### SUTHERLAND AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY HORSE SECTION RULES

- All animals entered into the Sutherland Show must be in good health. No animal suffering from any
  contagious disease will be allowed on the showground. The veterinary surgeon's decision will be final.
  The committee advises that all horses and ponies attending the Sutherland Show should have a current Equine
  Flu vaccination. Horses and ponies attending the Sutherland Show do so entirely at the owners' risk.
- 2. All horses and ponies attending the Sutherland Show MUST be accompanied by their passport which should be available for checking.
- 3. All animals must be kept under control at all times, otherwise their removal from the showground will be requested.
- 4. All judges' decisions shall be final. All jumping course heights will be at the course builder/judge's discretion.
- 5. Any objections must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary on the day of the show if possible, or within one week of the day of the show. A deposit of £10 shall be lodged for each objection raised and will be refunded if the objection is upheld. All objections shall be brought before the show committee as soon as practical and the decision of the committee shall be final.
- 6. The committee reserves the right to limit the use of incorrect tack or equipment.
- Approved headgear must be worn by entrants at all times while mounted and is strongly recommended for in-hand classes.
- 8. Entrants must respect the directions from Sutherland Show officials and helpers.
- 9. Judging will commence promptly as follows: Shetlands 8 a.m., Clydesdales 10 a.m. All Other Horses 8.30 a.m.
- 10. Classes will run in catalogue order.
- 11. Entries must be received by Thursday 27 June 2019 to appear in the catalogue. However, entries will be accepted until 14 July but will not appear in the catalogue. Entry fees must be received with entry forms or shown on entry form that payment will be made by BACS.
- 12. NO entries will be accepted after 14 July and NO entries will be accepted on show day.
- 13. Substitute horses (different from that shown on entry form) will not be accepted on show day.
- 14. No stallions or colts may enter the Ridden, In-Hand or Working Hunter classes.
- 15. All section winners and reserves and the Supreme Champion must remain on the show field and take part in the Grand Parade.
- 16. Entry fees are £6 per horse per class entered.
- 17. Prize money: Classes 1st £10, 2nd £7, 3rd £5 Sections Champion £25, Reserve £10 Supreme Champion £50
- 18. The organisers will take every precaution to ensure the safety of the public but accept no responsibility whatsoever for the injury or damage to any person, animal or property whilst on the showground, in the car park or on the approaches thereto.
- 19. Competitors are advised to ensure that they are adequately covered by their own insurance.
