## POULTRY SECTION RULES

- 1. To comply with APHA rules, all exhibitors must complete an entry form.
- 2. To comply with APHA rules, if birds were not kept at the address on the entry form during the 28 day period before the Sutherland Show, the address where they were kept during that period must be shown.
- 3. To comply with APHA rules, no person shall bring a bird to the Sutherland Show from a place outside Scotland, unless it has been kept at disease free premises for at least 28 days before the show.
- 4. The Society will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any exhibit or exhibitor's property.
- 5. The Society will not be responsible for exhibits entered in wrong classes.
- 6. The Committee reserves the right to appoint additional or substitute judges should this be necessary.
- 7. Classes will be reviewed annually according to entries.
- 8. Entry:- Poultry £1, Eggs 50p.

# 9. Entries need to be received by Thursday 27th June to be in the show catalogue. However, entries will be allowed until 14th July but will not be in show catalogue.

- 10. No exhibit may be removed from its pen except by a judge or the exhibitor.
- 11. Exhibits must be penned by **09.30am** when judging starts.
- 12. Exhibits may not be uplifted before 3.00pm on show day.
- 13. Pen numbers to be collected on day of show.
- 14. Only bedding supplied by the show will be permitted in the pens.
